JetCAPS AirProjector connects to your HP Digital Projector to let you operate your projector wirelessly, from almost any Windows PC or laptop equipped for wireless networking, using a simple, freely distributed, application.

how JetCAPS AirProjector works

The free JetCAPS AirProjector Client Software captures your PC display, compresses the image, and sends it to the AirProjector hardware unit, which de-compresses the image and displays it, in real-time, using the HP Digital Projector to which it is connected. By using standard IEEE 802.11b (a.k.a. 802.11b, WLAN, or WiFi) wireless LAN technology, the JetCAPS AirProjector can be used immediately with the many notebook PCs equipped for wireless networking, letting presenters operate the projector without having to be physically connected to it.

For added network security – a critical element for corporate and government installations – JetCAPS AirProjector also supports both the 64- and 128-bit-key encryption of the Wired Equivalent Privacy, or WEP, part of the IEEE 802.11b standard.

To ensure simple and straightforward use, the AirProjector Client Software automatically detects active and available JetCAPS AirProjectors on your wireless network – taking your PC's network configuration into account. Even first time users can be up and running in a matter of minutes.

- a convenient test button displays the current configuration on the projection screen

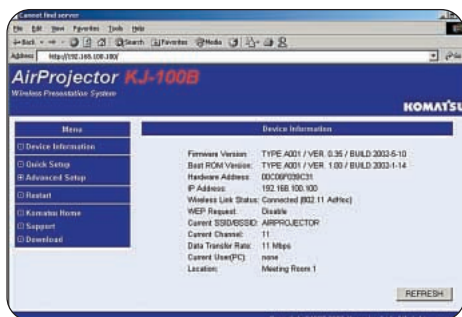
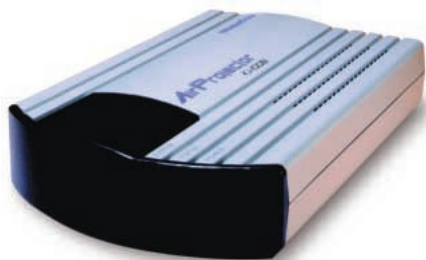
